DIRECTIONS TO BECOME A VOLUNTEER AT BRUSH CREEK ELEMENTARY

Go to www.eagleschools.net. On the Home Page click on the top right Menu button. Then hover over the DISTRICT INFO tab and then click on Careers. Scroll down and click on [online application](#). At the bottom of that screen you will see [Volunteer](#). Click on Apply. Follow the instructions.

Next you will need to go to the Eagle County Sheriff's Building at 0885 Chambers Ave to get your fingerprints taken. There is a \$15 fee, cash or personal check only. Once you receive your fingerprints please take them across the street to our ECSD office at 948 Chambers Ave. Tell them you are volunteering at Brush Creek Elementary.

It takes a few days for everything to process, but once you are cleared you are able to volunteer in the building or on field trips for 5 years.
