

## Gifted Identification Assessment Process

### Specific Talent Aptitude: Visual Arts

Identification in specific talent aptitude requires the examination of a variety of instruments and multiple pathways that lead to identification. Students may demonstrate unique and varied characteristics within the visual arts talent domain, and several years of talent development may be needed before formal gifted identification can be made. Students may be included in a talent pool to foster potential over time and to build a body of evidence that supports formal gifted identification. The following flowchart depicts the process used by Eagle County Schools for identification in visual arts.
