Positive cases at RSES and RCHS

Thirty students and six staff members will quarantine in total

Eagle, CO – Eagle County Schools notified parents of Red Sandstone Elementary School and Red Canyon High School of COVID-19 cases yesterday. In both cases, Public Health has conducted contact tracing and determined that those in close contact with the positive case need to be quarantined. At RSES, two positive student cases from the same household result in the transition of sixteen students and two staff members to remote learning while they quarantine. At RCHS, fourteen students and four staff members will quarantine and transition to remote learning after a student at the Edwards campus tested positive.

Students and staff may continue learning and working from home while on quarantine.

With parent support and collaboration, Eagle County Schools continues to safeguard against school transmission by adhering to our layers of protection:

- Staying home if sick
- Wearing face coverings
- Maintaining as much distance as possible
- Practicing good hand hygiene and frequent cleaning
- Conducting daily symptom screenings

The school district thanks Public Health for their ongoing support in managing this process and keeping our students and staff safe and healthy.
